

Rules:

\$10 entry fee

Distribution - \$3 for closest to the pin on every par 3. The remaining \$ will be split between the overall team winners

Triple bogey max

1st tee mulligan on each day

Day 1 – Tee times begin at **12:04**

Stableford scoring – Combined overall team score will decide the 1st day team winner.

The team with the most accumulated points wins.

No head to head matchups – No gimmes, putt out on every hole.

Triple Bogey = -1

Double Bogey = 0

Bogey = 1

Par = 3

Birdie = 5

Eagle = 7

Day 2 – Tee times begin at **9:16**

Match Play – 1 point will be awarded for an outright win and ½ point for ties for a total of 5 points. Matchups will be decided after the 1st round is complete Ryder Cup style. The team that wins the 1st day, gets the 1st pick.

1st round score will set everyone's handicap for match play.

Anyone on the opposing team can concede a putt.

If Player 1 (85 the 1st day) is matched up against Player 2 (90 the 1st day). Player 2 will get 5 shots. 1 shot on each of the 5 toughest holes (handicaps 1 -5). The rest of the holes will be played straight up.

If hole 3 is the 2nd toughest hole, Player 1 gets a 5 and Player 2 gets a 6, that hole is halved. If P1 gets a 5 and P2 gets a 5, Player 2 wins the hole.

Since we have 10 people, one match will be played in separate groups.

This is how it will look:

1st group: Team USA 1 vs Team Europe 1
Team USA 2

2nd group: Team Europe 2
Team USA 3 vs Team Europe 3

3rd group: Team USA 4 vs Team Europe 4
Team USA 5 vs Team Europe 5

If each team wins a day, we'll have a chip-off to determine the overall tournament winners.

There will also be an individual champion for the weekend so make sure to finish out the holes. No money will be awarded for this, only bragging rights for a year.
