Everybody should be at the course and at the driving range by <u>9:45</u>. The first group will tee off at <u>10:24</u>.

**Day 1 Rules:** Best Ball - Each player on the team plays his own golf ball throughout the round, and on each hole the low score - or "best ball" - of the group serves as the team score. Player A gets a 5 and Player B gets a 4, then the team score for that hole is 4, because the low score of the group was B's 4. Individual scores will also be kept for future seeding and handicapping purposes. Triple Bogey Max

**1**<sup>st</sup> **Day Pairings:** The first day pairings will be determined by the order in which the names are drawn. The first two names drawn will tee off in the foursome with the next two names and so on.

#### Closest to the Pin holes:

#7 - 145 yards #14 - 162 yards

Tee times begin at 8:32. Foursomes will be determined after the 1st round is complete.

**Day 2 Rules**: Captain's Choice – Each player tees off on each hole. The best of the tee shots is selected and all players play their second shots from that spot. The best of the second shots is determined, then all play their third shots from that spot, and so on until the ball is holed. Individual scores will not be kept.

**2<sup>nd</sup> Day Pairings**: The team with the highest 1<sup>st</sup> day score will tee off first, followed by the next highest score, etc. In the event of tie scores, a coin flip will determine which order the teams will tee off.

#### Closest to the Pin holes:

#5 – 141 yards #17 – 134 yards

## Tiebreaker:

If two or more teams are tied following the 2<sup>nd</sup> day, we will go to the scorecards to determine a winner. The final three holes will be added together for the 2<sup>nd</sup> round for each team. The team with the lowest score on the final 3 holes wins. If a winner is not determined, we will go to 4 holes, etc, until there is a winner.

There will be no individual champion for the Chubbs Peterson Shootout.

LUNCH and AWARDS CEREMONY to follow the last group. The course has a place where we can eat and hang for a while.

Everybody bring a camera or camera phone and take pictures and videos while you're playing.

# **Payouts:**

**1<sup>st</sup> Place**: \$100 will be awarded to each member of the winning team as well as a few other more important, non-monetary items

2<sup>nd</sup> Place: \$40 will be awarded to each member of the 2<sup>nd</sup> place team
